SUBJECT: Workforce Investment Board [WIB] Membership

PROPOSED MOTION(S): The WIB nominate Rhonda Walton, Dean Cormany and Robert McLaughlin to the Board of Supervisors for appointment to the WIB.

DISCUSSION:

The Law: Workforce Investment Act Section 117[c][1] [A] - The chief elected official in the local area is authorized to appoint members of the local board.

The Regulations: 20 CFR 661.300[a] - The Local Workforce Investment Board is appointed by the chief elected official in the local area.

WIB Bylaws para 5 - Vacancies on the Board shall be filled. . . . by the Merced County Board of Supervisors based on recommendations from the Board [WIB].

Two members, representing One-Stop partners, have retired : Grover Omyer, Human Services Agency and Dick Shipley, Department of Rehabilitation. Proposed replacements are: Rhonda Walton, Acting Director, Human Services Agency and Dean Cormany, District Administrator, State, Department of Rehabilitation. Mr. Cormany, who's office is in Fresno, is nominated because there is a State hiring freeze and Mr. Shipley's replacement may be delayed until July 2002 or later.

The Greater Merced Chamber of Commerce has nominated Mr. Robert McLaughlin to fill one of the four Private Sector vacancies on the WIB. Mr. McLaughlin is Vice President of Pacific Sieria Publishing [locally the Merced Sun Star].
