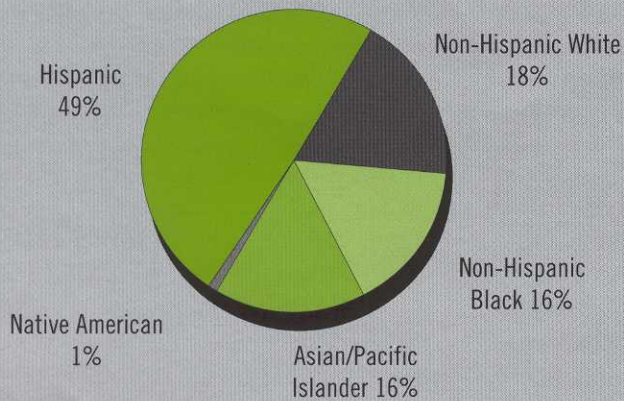


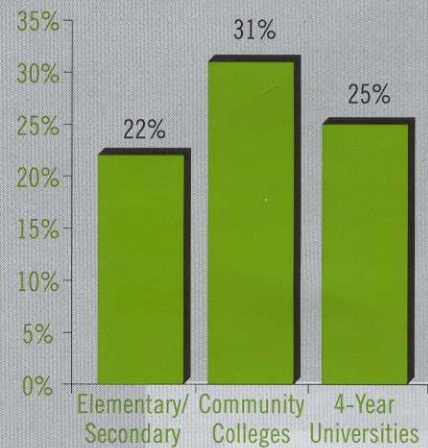

Four out of Five of the Additional College-Age Population Are Minority Youth



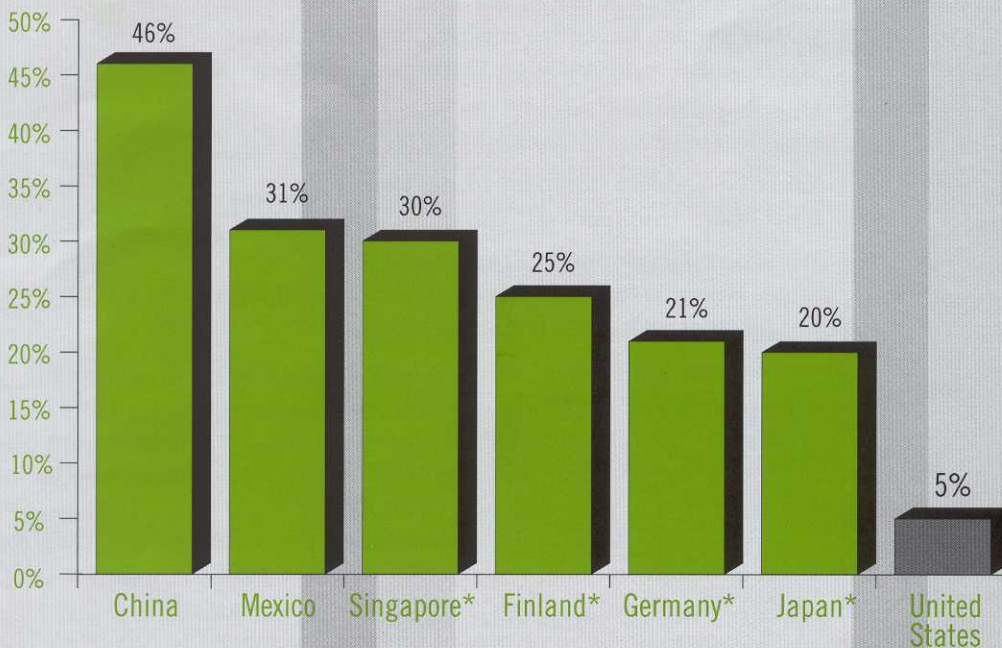

* Scored higher than U.S. students in math and science on the Third International Mathematics and Science Study.

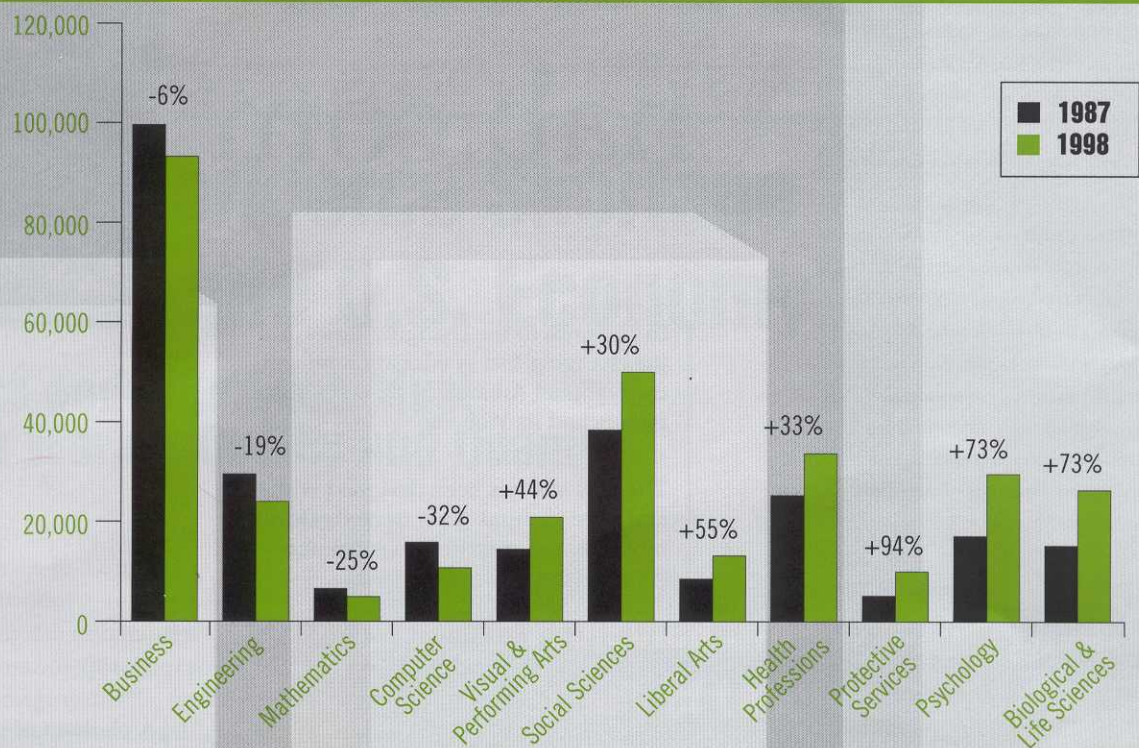

Early in this century, 60 percent of jobs will require skills that only 20 percent of the workforce currently possess.

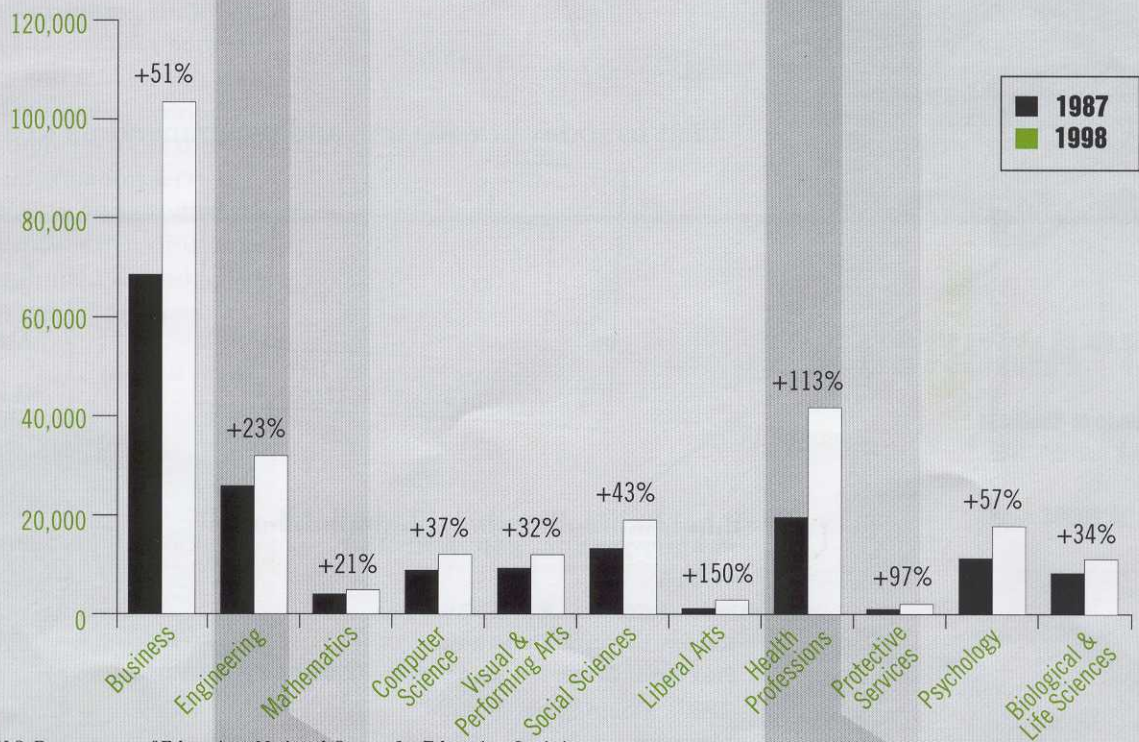
