

1. What is your vision of a *separated* WIB (i.e. WIB has its own budget and employees totally separate from PITD)?
 - a. Do you want separate WIB employees (i.e. non-PITD) staff to do the policy / strategic work of the WIB?
 - b. Do you also mean that the WIB employees (i.e. non-PITD employees) will be responsible for all of the administrative functions (i.e. monitoring, fiscal oversight, contracts management, federal audit management, etc.) as well?
 - c. If so to either, what are the advantages to doing it this way? What does a *separated* WIB get from doing all of that?
2. What can be accomplished by separating completely from PITD that can't be done now? Is the 'problem' real or perceptual?
3. Are there other ways to get those things? (i.e. Having a separate identity without being incorporated?)
4. What are the staff skills and competencies you think we need as a WIB to carry out the strategic plan?
5. Do you think the current PITD staff possesses those competencies?
6. You've discussed the idea of a separate WIB with some of the LEOs, what did they think of the idea?
