SUBJECT: LVN Grant Contracts

PROPOSED MOTION(S): Ratify the Executive Committee’s action to approve the five (5) contracts to purchase services required by the Dept of Labor – Community Based Job Training Grant.

DISCUSSION: The San Joaquin Valley Regional Nurse Collaborative, composed of the Counties of Merced, Madera and Stanislaus has been awarded \$1,850,443 to fund capacity building and training for the critical Licensed Vocational Nurses shortage in the San Joaquin Valley.

The contracts are with three community colleges and two local workforce investment areas. The college contracts fund one instructor, instructional supplies and grant-related travel. The workforce investment area contracts are for supportive services, case management and grant-related travel. All contracts are for a three-year period.
