

**Consultation from County Council
On
Candidates Invited to the WIB meeting.**

1. The candidates should be recognized for their contributions in the community.
(Example: Current office holder can be recognized for the contributions they have made to the actualization of UC Merced.)
2. Format of the candidate's part in the meeting should be determined in advance.
(Example: Educating candidates to issues that are important to the WIB.)
3. Subject matter should be within the WIB's jurisdiction.
 - Issues that pertain to WIB's jurisdiction.
 - Issues that support other organizations that relate to the WIB's jurisdiction
 - Issues that benefit the citizens of Merced County.
4. All candidates should be treated the same. A neutral approach should be taken.
5. Agendize candidates' part of the meeting and stay within the agenda.
6. Maintain adherence to the Brown act.
 - 72 hours notice of agenda items
 - Orderly
 - Not politicized
