SUBJECT: Determination of “Occupations in Demand”

PROPOSED MOTION: None

DISCUSSION:

The Law – WIA 134(d)(4)(A)(iii) Linkage to occupations in demand - - Training services provided under this paragraph shall be directly linked to occupations that are in demand in the local area, or in another area to which and adult or dislocated worker receiving such services is willing to relocate, except that a local board may approve training services for occupations determined by the local board to be in sectors of the economy that have a high potential for sustained demand or growth in the local area.

The Regulations - Subpart C—Training Services § 663.310 (c) – [One of the requirements is that the client] select a program of training services that is directly linked to the employment opportunities either in the local area or in another area to which the individual is willing to relocate.
