SUBJECT: Youth-to-Youth Conference

PROPOSED MOTION: That the Youth Council approve the Outreach and Education Committee's decision to hold a Youth-to-Youth Conference in 2003, and forward that decision to the Workforce Investment Board as information.

DISCUSSION: Youth Council members, staff and Youth-to-Youth 2002 Conference participants met on April 30, 2002 to critique the recent Youth-to-Youth Conference held in Merced. The following recommendations were made and approved by the Youth Council:

- a. Hold a subsequent conference in 2003; same place, date to be determined.**
- b. Target audience--youth on youth councils and youth targeted by youth councils as potential members.**
- c. Conference content--basically the same as Youth-to-Youth 2002, updated for today's youth, workshops made more physically active, compress information to make the conference workday shorter.**
- d. Involve Leadership and Marketing Committee. Large marketing effort required immediately.**
- e. After this next year, turn the concept over to the State Youth Council.**

A major difference in this conference will be the need for more Youth Council member involvement. Thanks go to Gary Derr for his past efforts, but his new PITD duties will not allow him to dedicate himself solely to the future conference.
